



Artezín is a brand that focuses on heirloom varieties and strives to handcraft these varieties, being sensitive to their inherent uniqueness and to the terroir in which they grow to create wines with pure varietal character. Artezín produces Zinfandel, Petite Sirah, Carignan and Charbono and adds Mourvèdre in 2011 —quite an interesting and diverse portfolio. To create these expressive wines, our winemaker seeks out sustainably farmed, family owned vineyards in Mendocino and Amador Counties and Dry Creek Valley. Most of these vineyards are farmed by second- and third-generation growers with whom we have enduring relationships.

Our flagship variety is Zinfandel. For over a century, some of the best Zinfandel was made from classic Old Italian field blends. True to its history, Artezín has captured the essence of these traditional practices by blending grapes from distinct vineyards to create true varietal character. Our Zinfandel is handcrafted to convey the elegance and complexity inherent in this grape, while expressing the individual terroir from which the blend is made.
