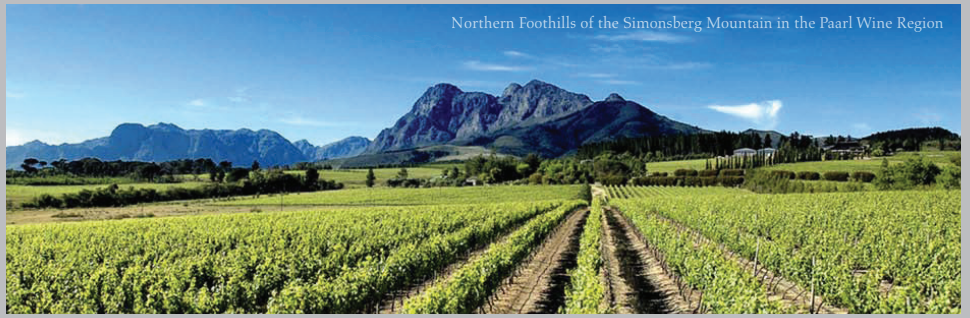

Wine Spectator | **91** points
NOVEMBER 15, 2010

This goes for power and pulls it off, displaying creamed melon, graham cracker, heather, grilled hazelnut and glazed pear flavors that all glide together through the long, lush finish. Drink now. 20 cases imported. -JM



Cabernet Sauvignon Paarl Gravel Quarry 2007

Wine Spectator | **90** points
NOVEMBER 15, 2010

This cuts a broad swath, delivering dense layers of plum, blackberry and red currant fruit supported by red licorice, roasted vanilla and coffee notes. Long and polished on the finish. Drink now through 2011. 100 cases imported. -JM



Chardonnay Paarl 2008

Wine Spectator | **88** points
NOVEMBER 15, 2010

A ripe, forward, crowd-pleasing style, showing a buttery edge to the pear and fig flavors, backed by a toasty, solid, medium-weight finish. Drink now. 5,000 cases imported. -JM



Grand Classique Paarl 2006

Wine Spectator | **87** points
NOVEMBER 15, 2010

Mature, with the grip now cedary and slightly taut, while the core of crushed plum, red currant and blackberry fruit melds with the tobacco and coffee notes. A cedar hint lingers on the finish. Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Malbec and Cabernet Franc. Drink now. 2,700 cases imported. -JM
