

What is "Temperature Control" shipping?

For the warm weather season, Temperature-Controlled shipping aka **FedEx Cold Chain**, starts shipping to southern states in May or June.

This shipping method transports and stores your wine at a stable 55-degree temperature until it reaches one of five hub stations throughout the United States. *The southern route is Dallas, Atlanta and Orlando. The northern route is Chicago and Newark.*

From the hub, FedEx Overnight Service picks up the shipment for overnight delivery to you. To a business address, delivery is scheduled before 10:30 AM. Residential addresses, delivery is before 12:00 PM.

Shipments leave California on a Friday and are delivered to Midwest states by Tuesday and East Coast states by Wednesday.

We appreciate your patience, as FedEx Cold Chain can take up to three weeks for delivery.
